

This guide can also be used for motor vehicle drivers who are taking the extra effort to share the road with motorcycle riders.

Motorcyclists face the greatest threat to their wellbeing and safety for many reasons, including:

- No seat belts
- No metal frame for protection from external elements
- No air bags

Injuries that motorcyclists involved in a motor vehicle accident sustain are often much more serious.

Common Motorcycle Accident Injuries

- Bone fractures and breaks
- Spinal cord injuries
- Traumatic brain injuries
- Neck and shoulder injuries

- Knee, ankle, & leg lacerations
- Cuts & abrasions
- Paralysis
- Amputation

Let's Take a Look at Motorcycle Accident Statistics in Georgia

Every year across the country, around **50,000 riders are injured and 2,000 killed** in motorcycle accidents.

What makes these crashes so dangerous is that motorcyclists are vulnerable in their exposure to elements that drivers and passengers of a motor vehicle are protected from.

In fact, motorcyclists are 16 times more likely to die in a crash than other automobile drivers.

55% of all motorcycle crashes involved another motor vehicle. 23% of all fatal motorcycle crashes resulted from collisions with fixed objects, which is more than drivers of motor vehicle accidents.
